

GENERAL NOTES (ENTIRE PROJECT):

- . THIS PROJECT SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CEDAR RAPIDS METROPOLITAN AREA STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS AND DETAILS FOR PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS, LATEST EDITIONS.
- 2. IT SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR TO PROTECT ALL EXISTING UTILITIES AND PAVED AREAS, INCLUDING ANY NOT SHOWN ON THESE DRAWINGS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY ALL EXISTING UTILITIES PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION AND NOTIFY THE ENGINEER IF ANY CONFLICTS WITH THE DRAWINGS OCCUR. ANY DAMAGE TO EXISTING UTILITIES, SOD, LANDSCAPE AND/OR PAVED AREAS CAUSED BY TRENCHING, GRADING, AND PAVING OPERATIONS NOT IDENTIFIED FOR REPLACEMENT SHALL BE REPAIRED AT THE CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE. EXISTING UTILITY LOCATIONS SHOWN ON THE DRAWINGS ARE APPROXIMATE.
- PROVIDE POSITIVE DRAINAGE AT ALL TIMES WITHIN THE CONSTRUCTION AREAS. DO NOT ALLOW WATER TO DRAIN OR TO POND ONTO ADJOINING PROPERTY OR PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY.
- 4. ALL DEBRIS RESULTING FROM CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS SHALL BE PROPERLY DISPOSED OF OFF-SITE.
- 5. RESTORE LANDSCAPED AND LAWN AREAS DISTURBED DURING CONSTRUCTION TO THEIR ORIGINAL CONDITION UPON COMPLETION OF CONSTRUCTION.
- 6. REMOVAL OF PCC SIDEWALK SHALL BE INCIDENTAL TO BID ITEM 02700-70 (PORTLAND CEMENT CONCRETE SIDEWALK).
