

MAYORAL PROCLAMATION NO. 01-09-16

WHEREAS, on September 23, 2016 the Cedar Rapids City Council adopted Resolution No. 1267-0916 which among other things declared a state of emergency in Cedar Rapids due to flooding conditions, and

WHEREAS, Iowa Code Section 372.14 (2016) provides for the Mayor to take certain actions during emergency conditions, and

WHEREAS, said Resolution also authorized the Mayor to take certain actions during the emergency including the establishment of a curfew.

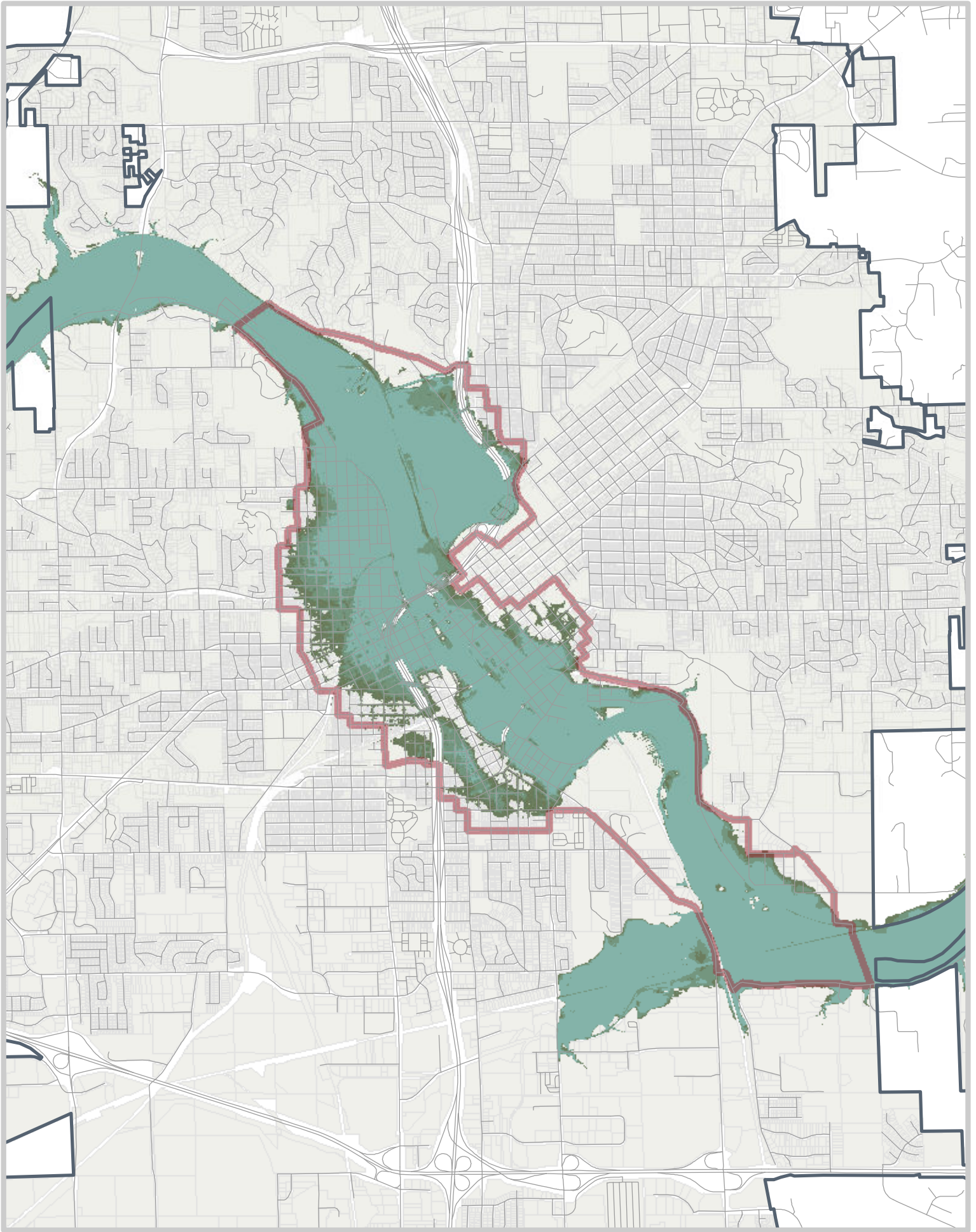
NOW THEREFORE, Ron Corbett, Mayor of the City of Cedar Rapids, hereby proclaims as follows:

1. Effective immediately, until the emergency conditions have ended as determined either by resolution of the City Council or mayoral proclamation, between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. all persons shall be prohibited from being upon all public streets, sidewalks, alleys or other public ways and grounds, or public and private property within all areas for which evacuation orders have been given as shown by Exhibit A attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein.
2. Officers of the Cedar Rapids Police Department and other law enforcement agencies assisting during this emergency are hereby authorized to take such actions necessary to enforce compliance with this proclamation and to protect and preserve the public health, safety, and welfare.
