



Automated Traffic Enforcement February 2020

During the month of **February**, Cedar Rapids Police Officers issued **13,705** citations identified by the Automated Traffic Enforcement system. These citations were issued to owners of vehicles traveling 12 MPH or more over the speed limit and/or running a red light. The Automated Traffic Enforcement Program has generated **\$1,262,560.42** during the month of **February**. To date, **\$6,552,694.09** has been generated since July 1, 2019.* City staff is currently pursuing Municipal Infractions to assist in collecting past due fines from vehicle owners due to violations of Cedar Rapids Municipal Code Section Chapter 61.138, Automated Traffic Enforcement. The collection of fines incurred from high-risk driving behavior including high rates of speed and repeated violations will be first priority.

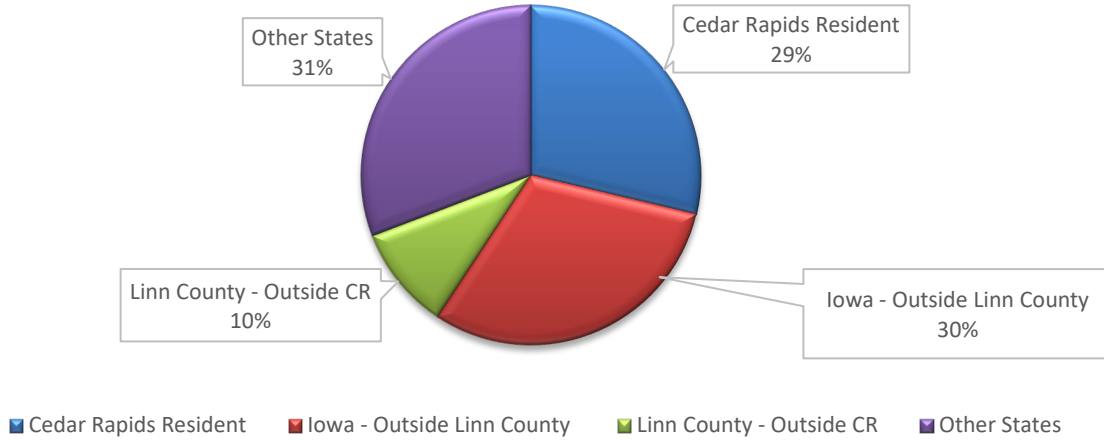

Citations Issued by Residency of Vehicle Owner

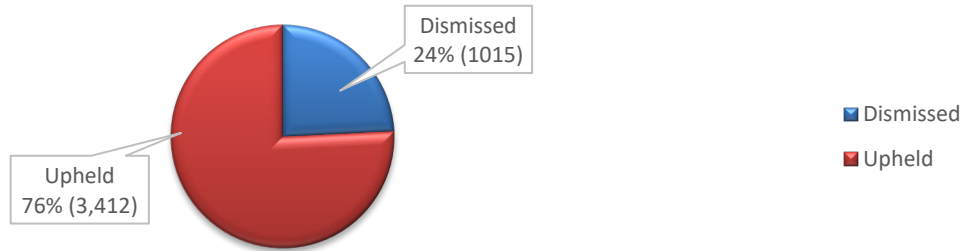
