

Automated Traffic Enforcement March 2020

During the month of March, Cedar Rapids Police Officers issued 17,022 citations identified by the Automated Traffic Enforcement system. These citations were issued to owners of vehicles traveling 12 MPH or more over the speed limit and/or running a red light. The Automated Traffic Enforcement Program has generated \$893,298 during the month of March. To date, \$7,242,270.17 has been generated since July 1, 2019.*




