

Three Station Tour: Live, Learn & Play

This 90 minute tour takes students to three different stations at Ushers Ferry Historic Village. They will spend 30 minutes exploring the Village, 30 minutes in the one room school house, and 30 minutes engaging in playtime activities that children did in the early 1900's.

Live:

This station will help students understand what life was like living in a community at the turn of the 20th century. This is led by an Ushers Ferry guide and includes a tour of the 1850's Usher Home and the Doctor's office.

Learn:

An Ushers Ferry guide will take students through a typical day in the one-room school house. They will have the opportunity to see what a classroom would have looked like and how a class would have been taught at the turn of the 20th century.

Play:

This portion of the Three Station Tour will be guided by teachers and chaperones. Students will be able to play games that kids did 100 years ago! Teachers will be provided with games before the tour to prepare.
