

Citizen Assistance Report

September, 2016

On 09/01/16, a citizen reported narcotics activity on Kirkwood Blvd SW. Officers located a number of narcotics related items and a wanted subject that was wanted on numerous warrants and Possession of a Controlled Substance-Meth, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and Providing False Information. Subject was also wanted by the Linn County Sheriff's Department reference a pursuit that occurred the night before when this subject was operating a stolen vehicle and got away from deputies.

On 09/03/16, a suspicious person is spotted on Dodge Rd. NE, after the subject jumped the fence in a parking lot. Subject was located near the bike path and arrested for Public Intoxication and Theft 5th.

On 09/04/16, officers responded to a call from a citizen on the SW side who reported a subject was kicking the door and throwing bricks at the residence. He was also in the possession of Marijuana. Officers located the subject, and he was charged with Criminal Mischief and Possession of a Controlled Substance – Marijuana.

On 09/06/16, a citizen reported a suspicious person on the NW side. Officers located a subject sleeping in the grass and a White 2003 Ford Expedition had stolen license plates on it. Officer's investigation shows the vehicle had been stolen. The subject was an escapee from Hinzman Center and was charged with vehicle theft and a hold order from Larry Nelson Center.

On 09/11/16, a citizen calls in from the NE side regarding a suspicious person entering a neighbor's home. Officers arrived and found a subject inside that had an outstanding warrant for FTA Unlawful Possession of Prescription Meds and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia x 2 and Occupying a Placarded Property.

On 09/15/16, a citizen from the SW side called police advising that a female had a knife. Officers checked the area, located the female, and she was charged with Carrying Weapons and Possession of a Controlled Substance.

On 09/16/16, CRPD received a call from several citizens reference a disturbance on the NE side. Callers advised that a male and female were fighting, and the male stated he had a gun and was going to shoot the female. Officers arrived on scene and had a foot pursuit with the male subject, who was later arrested and charged with Interference with Official Acts.

On 09/18/16, a caller reported a Theft In-Progress on the NW side. The victim observes a juvenile on a bike stealing items from his property. He chases him down and detains the subject until units arrive. The juvenile is taken into custody and charged with Theft 5th. Officers later determine that the bike he was on was reported stolen through our department. The juvenile suspect was also charged with Possession of Stolen Property.

On 09/24/16, a business owner called in a disturbance on the NE side. A female subject was located and arrested for Disorderly Conduct and Public Intoxication.

Subject: Flood 2016 Building Services
Date: October 24, 2016

Introduction

The Building Services Department was asked to prepare a summary of the operations related to the flood 2016. The following is a chronology of these operations.

- September 23rd - Building Services management staff ordered all staff on stand-by for any needed operations.
- September 24th through September 25th - Various staff members were called in off stand-by to assemble HESCO barriers and fill sandbags in support of temporary wall constriction.
- September 24th through September 25th - Staff worked on the logistics to create a contactor registration. The management of this registration transitioned to the Community Development Department to manage.
- September 24th through September 25th - Building Services management preliminary assembled 10 teams, 2 members each team, to perform damage assessments when needed. An additional 10 teams, 2 members each team, were also on stand-by if the damage levels were beyond the initial 10 teams. The teams assembled were made up of Building Services staff, various City staff, building inspectors from surrounding communities and members of the Iowa Association of Building Officials.
- September 26th through September 28th - Various members of the Building Services department assigned to walk locations along the temporary wall on 12 hour shifts to monitor for potential breaches.
- September 28th - Staff proposed to Mayor (became a Mayoral proclamation) to waive building permit fees associated with any work related to repairs caused by the flood. This included any equipment reconnects, such as furnaces, water heaters and commercial kitchen equipment.
- September 28th through September 29th - Staff began performing inspections in various areas of the City. Staff focused on areas where flood water damage was probable. This included but was not limited to Ellis Blvd. (wet side of temporary wall), Ellis Blvd. west of Edgewood Road, the Boat Harbor, Cedar Valley neighborhood, Time Check Neighborhood, Czech Village, Newbo area, Old River Road and the Otis Road. Staff found minimal visible over land damage. (See **Exhibit A** for map of inspections and **Exhibit B** for damage Summary)

- September 28th through September 29th – Staff spent a great deal of time in the Newbo area and Czech Village performing inspections and assisting business to return to operation. The businesses included but is not limited to Brewhemia, Tornado’s, The Newbo Market, Parlor City, Kick Stand, Lion’s Bridge Brewery.
- October 1st through October 2nd – Staff worked 8 hour shifts each day issuing permits and performing inspections. A majority of these inspections were related to furnace and water heater reconnections. Staff coordinated with Mid-American Energy to perform inspections in order to
- October 3rd through present - Continue to issue permits related to flood damage.
- To date a total of 108 permits have been issued. (See **Exhibit C** for permit details)

NUISANCE PROPERTY UPDATE

Since October 1, 2013 there have been **3,202** Founded Calls for Service of Chapter 22A which have affected **2,241** properties. Of the 22A Founded Calls for Service, **439** have met the threshold of 22A and have been deemed Nuisance Properties since the program started. Since October 1, 2014, **302** Nuisance Properties have been brought back into compliance. Of the **2,351** Tier C Founded Calls for Service, only **101** have resulted in a Nuisance Property Designation. SAFE-CR has billed **\$42,208.73** for Police Calls for Service and has collected **\$17,183.58**.

Based upon the following charts and graphs, property owners are abating the nuisance after they receive a Call for Service letter. Only **4.3%** of Tier C violations have risen to a Nuisance Property Designation and only **13.0%** of Nuisance Properties have had additional 22A violations billed.







NUISANCE ACTIVITY






Nuisance Activity Statistics for NE Quadrant






Top: Shows Nuisance Properties in NE Quadrant by Type of Activity 9-9-15 to 9-9-16






Top: Nuisance Property broken down by violation occurring in the Northwest Quadrant 9-9-15 to 9-9-16






Top: Nuisance Activity broken down by activity type occurring in the Southeast Quadrant 9-9-15 to 9-9-16






Top: Nuisance Property broken down by violation occurring in the Southeast Quadrant 9-9-15 to 9-9-16






Top: Nuisance Activity broken down by activity type occurring in the Southwest Quadrant 9-9-15 to 9-9-16







BACKGROUND CHECKS

The number of background checks requested through RentPrep has remained fairly consistent over the past several months. In September, 40 background checks were conducted. These checks were ordered by a total of 17 registered landlords with the City of Cedar Rapids. Overall, there have been 4,346 background checks ordered by 420 landlords. The background checks consist of a 50-state criminal history search, active Iowa warrants, Cedar Rapids arrests, as well as checks of the National Sex Offender Registry and the National Terrorist List.

Landlords also have the option to order additional screenings including Social Security Verification, Eviction Histories, and Lien/Bankruptcy Histories. 15 of the 40 (37.5%) background checks in September 2016 included these additional screens and 1,265 of the 4,347 (29.10%) total background checks included them.

16 of the 40 (40.0%) individuals screened in September 2016 yielded at least one reportable hit on their criminal history. Overall, 1,879 of the 4,346 (43.24%) background checks have at least one reportable offense in their criminal history. In accordance with the Fair Credit Reporting Act, a misdemeanor crime is reportable for 7 years and a felony is reportable for the lifetime of the individual.

Overall Statistics

- 50.51% of the prospective tenants currently living in Cedar Rapids yielded a reportable criminal history (1,249 of 2,473)
- 48.21% of the prospective tenants currently living in Linn County yielded a reportable criminal history (1,425 of 2,956)
- 45.97% of the prospective tenants currently living in Iowa yielded a reportable criminal history (1,656 of 3,602)
- 29.93% of the prospective tenants currently living outside of Iowa yielded a reportable criminal history (223 of 745)

The top 5 misdemeanor and felony violations found are shown below. The offenses are broken down by state of arrest, as many states have different qualifications for offenses (i.e. what may be a misdemeanor in one state is a felony in another). All offenses shown below are defined by the Iowa State Code unless otherwise noted.





by School Type & Month/Year








Juvenile Arrests at Schools


