




### Status of Open Complaints

## *NUISANCE PROPERTY UPDATE*

Since October 1, 2013 there have been **2,786** Founded Calls for Service of Chapter 22A which have affected **1,972** properties. Of the 22A Founded Calls for Service, **388** have met the threshold of 22A and have been deemed Nuisance Properties since the program started. Since October 1, 2014, **259** Nuisance Properties have been brought back into compliance. Of the **2,438** Tier C Founded Calls for Service, only **102** have resulted in a Nuisance Property Designation. SAFE-CR has billed **\$41,839.31** for Police Calls for Service and has collected **\$14,915.36**.

Based upon the following charts and graphs, property owners are abating the nuisance after they receive a Call for Service letter. Only **4.2%** of Tier C violations have risen to a Nuisance Property Designation and only **13.9%** of Nuisance Properties have had additional 22A violations billed.

## SAFE-CR Outstanding Invoices

SAFE-CR has been working with the City's Legal Department and Building Services to determine how to collect outstanding fees and fines for excessive Police Calls for Service to a property. There are multiple Property Owners with outstanding invoices that have not been paid. After much discussion amongst City staff, it was determined the most efficient way to collect outstanding fees and fines for rental properties is by suspending Rental Unit Registrations for properties with unpaid and overdue invoices. Chapter 29 of the Cedar Rapids Municipal Code states:

### 29.36 - SUSPENSION, REVOCATION OR DENIAL (OF LANDLORD BUSINESS PERMIT OR RENTAL UNIT REGISTRATION); RIGHT OF APPEAL; ORDER OF PRECEDENCE.

#### a. Suspension, Revocation or Denial of Rental Unit Registration or Landlord Business Permit.



Using the Order of Precedence outlined in subsection b. of this section as a guiding principle for gaining compliance, the code official may revoke, suspend, deny, or deny renewal of any Rental Unit Registration or Landlord Business Permit issued under this Subchapter where any of the following applies:

- i. False statements on any application or information or report required by this Subchapter to be given by the applicant, registrant, or permit holder.
- ii. Failure to pay any application, penalty, re-inspection, or reinstatement fee required by this Chapter, Chapter 22A of the Cedar Rapids Municipal Code or City Council Resolution.
- iii. Failure to correct deficiencies within the time frame specified in a Notice of Violation issued pursuant to this Chapter.
- iv. Failure to comply with the provisions of an approved mitigation/remediation plan by the code official.
- iv. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Title VIII of the Fair Housing Act of 1968 (as amended).
- v. Declaration of status as Nuisance Property pursuant to Chapter 22A of the Cedar Rapids Municipal Code.
- vi. Failure to provide proof of a Mandatory Tenant Background Check required by this Subchapter.

SAFE-CR mailed certified letters to each Property Owner still in violation of Chapter 29 to ensure they are aware that they are in violation. In addition to suspending the Rental Unit Registration, SAFE-CR is working with Alex Anderson and Trish Kropf to submit outstanding invoices to small claims court if the property has been sold or the property is owner occupied. 





### NUISANCE ACTIVITY






## Nuisance Activity Statistics for NE Quadrant






**Top:** Shows Nuisance Properties in NE Quadrant by Type of Activity 5-20-15 to 5-20-16






**Top:** Nuisance Activity broken down by activity type occurring in the Southwest Quadrant 5-20-15 to 5-20-16



## BACKGROUND CHECKS

The number of background checks requested through RentPrep has remained fairly consistent over the past several months. In May, 75 background checks were conducted. These checks were ordered by a total of 23 registered landlords with the City of Cedar Rapids. Overall, there have been 3,844 background checks ordered by 402 landlords. The background checks consist of a 50-state criminal history search, active Iowa warrants, Cedar Rapids arrests, as well as checks of the National Sex Offender Registry and the National Terrorist List.

Landlords also have the option to order additional screenings including Social Security Verification, Eviction Histories, and Lien/Bankruptcy Histories. 24 of the 75 (32%) background checks in May 2016 included these additional screens and 1,092 of the 3,844 (28.41%) total background checks included them.

33 of the 75 (44%) individuals screened in May 2016 yielded at least one reportable hit on their criminal history. Overall, 1,666 of the 3,844 (43.34%) background checks have at least one reportable offense in their criminal history. In accordance with the Fair Credit Reporting Act, a misdemeanor crime is reportable for 7 years and a felony is reportable for the lifetime of the individual.

### Overall Statistics

- 50.91% of the prospective tenants currently living in Cedar Rapids yielded a reportable criminal history (1,113 of 2,186)
- 48.38% of the prospective tenants currently living in Linn County yielded a reportable criminal history (1,270 of 2,625)
- 46.16% of the prospective tenants currently living in Iowa yielded a reportable criminal history (1,465 of 3,174)
- 30.00% of the prospective tenants currently living outside of Iowa yielded a reportable criminal history (201 of 670)

The top 5 misdemeanor and felony violations found are shown below. The offenses are broken down by state of arrest, as many states have different qualifications for offenses (i.e. what may be a misdemeanor in one state is a felony in another). All offenses shown below are defined by the Iowa State Code unless otherwise noted.




## Juvenile Arrests at Schools



## Citizen Assist Summary

On 05/01/16 at approximately 0038, officers responded to a Dispatch call at Cooter's Bar at 721 1st Ave. SW in reference to a citizen calling Dispatch about a fight that was going to happen at the bar. When officers arrived, two subjects were fighting. Both subjects were taken into custody and charged with Disorderly Conduct.

On 05/09/2016 at approximately 0400 hours, officers were dispatched to the 700 block of 18<sup>th</sup> St. SE after receiving information that a wanted subject was in the area. Officers arrived in the area and located the subject wanted on an Identify Theft warrant. Subject was transported to the Linn County Correctional Facility.
