The following questions and/or clarifications were asked relative to the above-listed Request for Bid. This memo is sent for clarification to all companies to whom the bid was sent.

Question: Will you accept primer base and enamel finish, in lieu of powder coat?

Answer: Yes

Question: Electric over hydraulic? This is an older style of brake operation and we would recommend full electric to reduce cost and maintenance.

Answer: Trailer shall be provided as noted in bid document, electric brakes and hydraulic for the drop deck.

Question: Auto deck latch? Is this a tilt function trailer? If so, what is min/max tilt angle that would be accepted?

Answer: This is not a tilt function trailer.

Question: Tube frame, will you accept a channel frame?

Answer: Yes

Question: Do you have a preference on type/size of cross members?

Answer: 2"x#" tube frame cross members on 16" centers

Question: Hitch for locking walk behind line striper...please describe further, I am understanding that you would place the striper in the trailer bed, toward the front and need to secure it...does the hitch need to protrude into the bed?

Answer: Yes

Question: If so, How far?

Answer: 4"

Question: Type of hitch required, placement height?

Answer: Clevis

Question: Do you want centered or offset on one side?

Answer: Offset

Question: Power unit: We use Haldex Brand products is this ok?

Answer: Yes

Question: Stencil Rack: How many shelves?

Answer: This is a vertical rack.

Question: How large opening for each?

Answer: 1-1/2"

Question: How much weight will it need to accommodate?

Answer: 100lbs

Question: Does the rack need to be secured with pin release type attachments?

Answer: No, secured down by bolts.

Question: Cone holders: How Many?

Answer: 5 holders on each side to hold 12 cones each.

Question: Mount for 2-wheel dolly, what type of mount?

Answer: Bracket

Question: 7-Pin Flat Connector? Can you please verify...most current pick-up trucks come with 7-way RV connector standard.

Answer: 7-way RV connector is fine.

Question: Where do you want the undercoating applied, underside of trailer only or also to forward facing items, example (front side of fenders, a-frame tongue area, front side of the Pan)?

Answer: Undercoating shall be applied to the underside of the trailer only.
