



Arabesque design inspired by the Mother Mosque of America



Geometric depiction of the Cedar River and the four quadrants




Czech floral design inspired by the Czech history in Cedar Rapids

An abstract print based on 0's and 1's (computer code) that is inspired by the Tech Corridor and the technology based work of NewBoCo




A fun way to highlight the prevalence of corn processing in Cedar Rapids
