Citizens are requested to **report** utility cutoffs, water levels in basement, and any structural problems to the Building Services Number. Please leave your name, address and phone number by calling 319-286-5903. An inspector will contact you and come to your home to assess the damage.



If your property was assessed as unsafe, please follow these steps:

For **electrical service** turned off by Alliant Energy, you will need to hire a contractor to assess and/or repair the damage. The contractor will obtain a permit from the City, and a City inspector will inspect the work, providing a release number to Alliant Energy. Electricity will then be turned back on by Alliant Energy.

For **gas service** turned off by MidAmerican Energy : MidAmerican will perform an assessment to determine whether they can turn it back on. If appliances were compromised, they will require that you hire a contractor and obtain a permit, and have the City inspect the repair work prior to MidAmerican turning the gas back on. No permits are required for Mech Equip repair only.
