

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

SPONSOR'S RESPONSIBILITY:

Ensure Agreement has been signed and approved by the respective City Department prior to beginning any operations as requested herein.

Agree to indemnify and hold harmless the City of Cedar Rapids, the Department, its Commission, its officers and employees from all liability, judgment, costs, expenses and claims growing out of damages or alleged damages of any nature whatsoever to any person, property or third party arising out of the performance or non performance of said work. Sponsor acknowledges that certain safety risks exist in all work areas.

Ensure Right-of-Way markers and land monuments are not removed, altered or damaged.

Carry out the work as required and authorized by this Agreement with serious regard to the safety of the volunteers, or employees of the sponsor, adjacent property owners and the traveling public.

Ensure Safety vests and gloves are worn by all persons while performing approved work whether on the public right-of-way, or on public property.

Perform the approved work during daylight hours, in a satisfactory, safe and professional manner.

Conduct a minimum of two safety meetings per year with volunteers, or employees, who are participating in litter or illegal dumping clean up activities.

Provide adult supervision at Park, or Trail work site when volunteers, or employees, are 14 years of age or younger.

Obtain all required supplies and materials necessary to carry out the approved work from the respective City Department during their regular business hours.

Place all trash bags and separated material at the location, or locations, designated by the respective City Department representative for subsequent pickup and disposal by the Department.

Inform the Department via a written list of large, heavy, or hazardous items found within the work area.

Plant all Right-of-Way harvested seed on public grounds as approved.

Return all unused materials and supplies furnished by the respective City Department to the Department following completion of approved work.

DEPARTMENT'S RESPONSIBILITIES:

Provide safety vests, gloves, trash bags, instructional and safety literature to Sponsor(s).

Remove trash bags and separated material cleaned up by Sponsor(s).

Remove large, heavy, or hazardous items, which are found.

ADDITIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES FOR PUBLIC ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAYS

SPONSOR'S RESPONSIBILITIES:

Participants must be 14 years of age, or older, to perform the authorized work specified within a road Right-of-Way.

Do not park, or store, vehicles, equipment or materials on the public right-of-way where it is unsafe, or posted.

Do not work on medians, or any portion of the traveled road Right-of-Way.

Place all trash bags and separated material at the location, or locations, designated by the respective City Department representative for subsequent pickup and disposal by the Department.
