Pool Closings

Bender Pool may close for any of the following reasons: mechanical breakdown, inclement weather, low participation, chemical imbalance, or schedule changes.

Locker Rooms

The pool has locker rooms equipped with showers, hair dryers, electrical outlets, baby changing tables, and 25¢ coin lockers. Lockers are not for overnight use. The Parks & Recreation Department is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Pool Accessibility

Bender Pool is disabled accessible and is equipped with a hydraulic chair and sloping steps in addition to traditional pool ladders.

CAMERA AND CELL PHONE USE IS PROHIBITED IN LOCKER ROOMS.

PATRONS ARE REMINDED OF THE FOLLOWING:

Children, age 5 and under, must be accompanied by and constantly supervised by an adult within arm's length.

Youths, 6-10 years of age, must be accompanied and supervised by an adult or responsible person of at least 14 years of age.

Children's swimsuits with permanent built-in floats are permitted but highly discouraged. Swimsuits with removable floats are **not** permitted.

T-Shirts, cut-off jeans or sweatpants are not permitted. Actual swim attire is required.

Swim diapers are mandatory for children who are not toilet trained. They are available from the pool cashier for a nominal charge.

HEALTH NOTICE!

Swimmers who are or have been sick may not enter the water for two weeks after the last episode of diarrhea. This applies to children and adults. Please keep everyone healthy.
