Please note the following specification changes/additions/clarifications relative to the above Request for Bid.

- Question: Does the city have a permanent VPN solution in place?
  Answer: Yes. NetMotion is typically used for mobile data computers. Dell (Aventail) is used for City domain access.
- 2) Question: Does the radio system have Type 1 or Type 2 vocoders on the P25 radio system? Answer. Currently the City of Cedar Rapids segment of our Harris P25 800MHz trunking radio system is all Phase 1 or FDMA. There are segments of the Harris system that are Phase 2 TDMA.
